Mob set 4-man gang ablaze days after 2 suffered same fate in Warri

A 4-man robbery gang was on Sunday July 3 set ablaze by angry mob in front of God's Kingdom Society along Warri Sapele road, Warri, Delta State, after men of the Nigerian Army killed two members of the gang.

An eye witness, Mr. Tony Uwaramah who narrated the incident to *Our Senior Correspondent* at the scene, said the four man gang was caught while stealing phones, cash and bracelets from innocent citizens at Enerhen. The gang was in the process of stealing a necklace from a victim when men of the Nigeria Army coming from the Hausa quarters end of Warri ran into them and immediately gun down two of them.

While the other two were apprehended by angry mob as they tried to escape. It was reliably gathered that all four members of the gang, including the two killed by men of the Nigerian Army were subsequently set ablaze by the mob.

Another eye witness who corroborated the story said the incident occurred about 3:30 in the afternoon. He gave the names of the three members of the gang as Ferguson, Feghor and Daniel. He disclosed that they were residents of Enerhen who has been terrorizing innocent passersby for a long time.

Fresh Angle could not speak with the police team from 'A' Division in Warri who stormed the scene as they were obviously indisposed to media briefing even though they allowed Journalists to do their jobs. One of them openly warned a reporter not to take photograph of the police together with the remains of the robbers.

Fresh Angle can report that the burning of the four robbers is coming on the heels of the burning of two others in Airport road by Total filling station in Warri Thursday June 30 as well as the killing of another hoodlum caught vandalizing armoured cable by mobile policemen on early morning patrol along the Ugbuwangue end of NPA Expressway in Warri. Two other members of the gang vandalizing the armoured cable used for street light beautification escaped while another member of the gang was allegedly arrested.

It would be recalled that we had reported a possible upsurge of crime and other vices following increase in unemployment in Delta State.
