Bandit escapes, as mob set 2 suspected armed robbers ablaze in Warri

In what can be described as a renewed wave of extra judicial killing of suspected armed bandits, 2 suspected armed robbers were on Monday October 17 set ablaze by angry mob in Ugbori area of Warri exactly 24 hours after 2 others suffered same fate at the Airport road end of the city.

An eyewitness told **Fresh Angle** that the armed robbers had embarked on a car snatching mission at Ekurede –Itsekiri from an unidentified woman. According to the witness, the woman was stabbed by the armed robbers and in the process she alerted people in the area by shouting “*ole, ole, ole ooooo*”.

The witness further alleged that the bandits were 3 in number but in the process of their attempted escape, their motorbike collided with another transporter (okada rider) at the Olu Palace junction in Warri. Immediately the commercial motorcyclists around sensed they were armed robbers who were ambushed by angry mob, 2 of the robbers were set
