In another development, a minor traffic misunderstanding between two Ibo traders in Freetown Street of Sabon Gari has resulted in the death of one of them.

This occurred between the hours of 10 and 11p.m. on Saturday night in front of a popular drinking place on Freetown Street, where the vehicle of the suspect (names withheld) broke down and obstructed the passage of the deceased.
