

# 7-month baby girl raped

A SEVEN-MONTH old baby girl has been reported raped in a brothel at Sani Giwa Street in Sabon Gari, Kano Sunday.

This ugly incident occurred at a popular brothel on Sani Giwa Street where the mother of the baby (names withheld) is said to be sharing a room with a girlfriend to the suspected rapist.

A reliable source told *Daily Triumph* on condition of anonymity "that the suspected rapist (names withheld) visited the brothel on that day, met the two roommates the mother of the baby

(victim) and her roommate outside where he bought them drinks.

"As they were drinking, the suspect (who is said to be a cleaner with the Central Bank of Nigeria) feigned tiredness and went into the room to re-

lax," he disclosed.

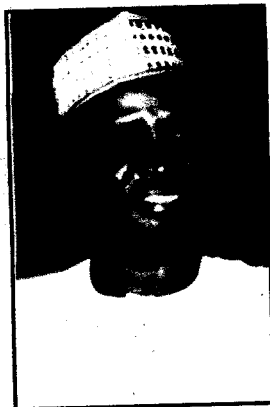
Meanwhile, the baby girl was laid on a bed in the room for her evening nap, when the suspect carried out the dastardly act and left the room soon after. The baby girl was discovered by the mother who met her unconscious and bleeding profusely from her genital area and raised an alarm.

*Triumph* can report authoritatively that investigations are in top gear and the suspect will soon be arraigned before an appropriate court of law.

In another development, a minor traffic misunderstanding between two Ibo traders in Freetown Street of Sabon Gari has resulted in the death of one of them.

This occurred between the hours of 10 and 11p.m. on Saturday night in front of a popular drinking place on Freetown Street, where the vehicle of the suspect (names withheld)

broke down and obstructed the passage of the deceased.

According to an eyewitness, both parties got involved in a hot argument that resulted in fisticuffs and in a fit of rage, the suspect picked up his car jack and hit the deceased on the head.

The deceased who was to get married in December, thereafter slumped immediately and was rushed to the hospital where he died two days later without regaining consciousness.

Meanwhile, the suspect is in police net awaiting his fate at a court of law.
