The assassins got into

the one-room apartment, met his houseboy and asked him the where-abouts of his boss for which he said that he wasn't around and the assassins told him their mission that they were there to kill his boss and later they tied him up with rope and carted him away with the sum of N11,000.

The suspected assassins then went into the main

Kallamu and asked him also about whereabout of his brother, for which he equally told them he was yet to be back.

The killers told him that, they were there to kill his brother but since he was not around they will fulfil their mission by killing him and before the blink of the eyes, one of them had brought out a pistol and shot him dead.

When Daily Triumph correspondent went to the Kaduna state police command for comment, the Police Public Relations Officer confirmed the incident, saying that they will do everything possible to identify the killers as their men have c o m m e n c e d investigation.
