

○ A HERBALIST, who allegedly killed his client while testing the potency of a charm against gun shots prepared for the deceased, has been arrested by the police in Delta state.

The commissioner of Police, Prince Udom Ekpoudom, said the herbalist, one Okammuo Orebal, hails from Anambra.

He said, the suspect had, on the last Christmas day, shot dead one Christian Alieze from Ebonyi, who had engaged him to prepare the charm for him.

The commissioner said, the incident took place at Isiokolo in Delta State.
