

Robbers shoot 2 soldiers dead

TWO soldiers were shot dead by a gang of armed robbers last Saturday morning at Falgore bush in Doguwa local government area of Kano state.

The incidence occurred between the first and second military gates of Dokoki, Gada Biyu at Falgore.

Our correspondent who is on his way to Riruwai town to an event, escaped the robbery attack following a signal from villagers in the area.

While our correspondent and other travellers were waiting to see the way opened, two people on a motorcycle

came with one of the victims who was shot in his waist who was later taken to Tudun Wada Hospital for urgent medical treatment.

When the robbers left the scene, our correspondent who arrived there later, learnt that two soldiers were shot dead while others sustained injuries.

Narrating his ordeal to our correspondent, one of the victims of the robbery attack who was in the same

Wada, and on their way, one soldier from one of the military gates in Falgore also joined the bus and that upon reaching another gates, the soldier colleague asked him where he was going to, and he replied that he was going to Tudun Wada to take injection because he was not feeling fine.

The escaped victim added that, one of the soldier colleagues at the site followed him, with all the soldiers sitting at the front seat of the bus, as they continued moving almost to the end of the bush, which is about to the last gate.

"I just heard gun shot while I was sitting at the back seat," he narrated.

"When the car finally stopped, the robbers came and seized the two guns of the soldiers who we learnt that were killed.

"I fell down unconscious and later woke up and run to the bush and when I regained

my consciousness, I learnt that the robbers had left," he further narrated.

"I did not sustain any injury and I can recall that when our bus was forced to stop, I saw many people flat on the roadside as directed by the robbers", the anonymous victim added.

"I also recalled that when the robbers took away the soldiers' guns, one of the robbers started 'saying let's go'".

In another development, the renowned anti-robbery crusader, Ali Kwara has killed four armed robbers in Garun Malam local government area of Kano state.

Daily Triumph learnt that all the robbers were Fulani men and resembled each other while one of them was wearing a police uniform and all were in possession of guns and ammunitions.

Meanwhile, efforts to get police version of the incident however, proved abortive.

THE death has been announced of the District Head of Fagge, *Kachallan Kano*, Alhaji Muhammadu Mustapha Galadima at Fagge quarters on Saturday, June 29, 2007.

The deceased died after a brief illness at the age of 45, and left behind one wife, one child, sisters and brothers.

Among his brothers are Alhaji Ibrahim Galadima, former chairman of the Nigeria Football Association (NFA), Alhaji Abba Galadima, Assistant Director with KNUPDA, Alhaji Sunusi Galadima who is the Galadima of Fagge and Alhaji Muhammadu Galadima, a banker with Inland Bank Plc, Kano.

Meanwhile, the Chief Imam of Fagge Juma'at Mosque, Sheikh Nasiru Muhammad Nasir led the funeral prayer yesterday and the burial was attended by *Wamban Kano*, Alhaji Abbas Sunusi, *Madakin Kano*, Alhaji Abdullahi Sarki Sani Yola, Alhaji Chief (Dr.) G.A. Bello and Senator Muhammadu Bello among others.
