Heavy downpour kills 1, destroys houses in Katsina

Heavy rainfall has killed one person and destroyed several houses within Katsina metropolitan area.

As a result of the rainfall, many people have been rendered homeless in addition to losing many properties.

Our correspondent learnt that Katsina metropolitan area has for several years witnessed destruction of houses as many of such houses were built along river ways.

In the last one week, Katsina has witnessed heavy rainfall which turned some areas difficult for the residents to conduct their day-to-day businesses.
