Police to quiz 3 women over death of 5 girls

IN a bid to unravel the mystery surrounding the death of five girls recently in Ado-Ekiti, the Ekiti State police command may interrogate three women identified as Medina, Mary and Sade over the matter.

The kids, children of Mr. Mutiu Nurein, a butcher, were found dead in the booth of their father's Mercedes Benz 190 car, which was parked within their premises at Ureje Quarters, off Ado-Ikare Road, last Saturday.

The father of the girls, in an interview with newsmen on the telephone on Tuesday, said he quarrelled with the three women, who were his neighbours at Irona Quarters in Ado-Ekiti.

He said the women were to be interrogated by the police to help them in their investigations.

According to Nurein, the women had engaged him in a fight sometime ago, during which he taunted them with the death of one their brothers recently.

Reacting to the incident, the state Police Commissioner, Chris Ola, who confirmed the decision of the police authorities to invite the women, said they had spoken with the only survivor of the incident, Rasidat.
