# Police arrest hunter for killing colleague in Osun

A hunter, Ajani Moshood, has been arrested by the police in Osun State for allegedly killing his colleague, one Amusan Hammed, during a hunting expedition at Mokore farm settlement near Orile-Owu town in Ayedade Local Government area of Osun State.

The suspect was said to have mistaken his colleague for an animal and shot at him. The suspect, who lives at Apena Compound in Orileowu, was said to have reported himself to the police after the sad incident

The 57-year-old suspect told the police that he shot his colleague mistaking him to be an antelope .

Ajani was said to be remorseful after the incident. The corpse of Amusan was, however, removed from the farm and deposited at the mortuary of the Obafemi Awolowo University Teaching Hospital, Ile-Ife, for autopsy.

Confirming the incident, the state Commissioner of Police,  ${\sf Mr}$  Solomon Olusegun, said the case would be thoroughly investigated.

The suspect was said to have been earlier detained at the Gbongan Police Division for preliminary investigation and later transferred to the state Criminal Investigation Department (CID) in Osogbo.

The killing of Amusan was said to have caused pandemonium in the town, as angry mob protested his death and accused Ajani of killing the deceased intentionally.

The angry mob burnt property of the suspect during the protest.

Some resident of the town alleged that Ajani was notorious criminal and that he had killed some people in the past They recalled that Ajani killed one Adegboye sometimes ago and removed his throat .
