But, when Amina stopped by filling station, the manager told her that armed robbers had her

But, when I entered the family house, I was informed after some minutes of preaching from the Holy Qur'an. I was taken in to give him my last respects and pray for him. That was how I lost a caring, responsible, decent, honest and polite husband who really changed my life for the better. My problem now is that I cannot forget him in my lifetime," Amina wailed.

After some time, Amina recalled how she met him. "It was through one of his cousins, Hajia Binta Rabe who resides at Layou Katsina. She always informed me that she will connect me with one of his cousins. So, one day, I was just passing and she called me and invited me with Hadi. We spoke for less than 15 minutes. Then he was a student at Isa Katsina College of Administration
