Three die in communal clash

ILORIN— THE age long boundary disputes between the people of Offa, Offa local government and Erinile community in Oyun local government areas of Kwara state erupted again yesterday.

Three persons were confirmed dead at press time while several others were on danger lists at an undisclosed hospital in offa town.

While the crisis lasted a multimillion naira sawmill at the boundary site few metres after the Federal Polytechnic had been razed to ashes, while two of the victims were simply identified as Hussein Agidingbi and One Deji.

Eyewitness account told *Vanguard* that the crisis broke out about 2pm in the afternoon when the people of Erinile allegedly went to the Saw Mill factory located at the boundary between the two communities to chase the planks sellers away on the ground that the factory was on their land.
