

# Gummen storm guber aspirant's house, kill Policeman, motorcyclist

**JOS**—AN Assistant Superintendent of Police and a commercial motorcycle rider were gunned down on Wednesday night in the Plateau State capital when armed

men stormed the residence of an ACD governorship aspirant, Mr. Pam Dung Gyang. Two residents of the house have also been hospitalized for gunshot wounds.

The armed men suspected to be robbers stormed the house located along Tudun Wada Ring Road at about 8.00pm shooting indiscriminately.

The robbers were said to have laid an ambush for the police patrol team which responded to the distress call of the occupants of the house and opened fire on them as they approached the residence killing the officer who headed the team instantly.

The commercial motorcycle rider was said to have been hit by a stray bullet and he rode past the area sending him to his early grave.

Both Mr. Gyang and his wife were said to be away to Abuja at the time the robbers visited the residence but sources said they collected jewellery, cash and other valuables from the house.

The Police Public Relations Officer, Deputy Superintendent Dominic Iornumbe who confirmed the incident to newsmen said the robbers made away with the ASP's AK47 rifle and 20 rounds of ammunition.

He added that the police have commenced investigations but that no arrest had been made.
