

Mob kills policeman

PORT HARCOURT—A POLICE man was killed by a mob in Port Harcourt yesterday. The deceased was driving an Isuzu car which

rammed into a motor-bike from the rear. The bike somersaulted resulting in the death of a female passenger, her child and the *okada* rider.

The incident provoked passers-by who descended on

the policeman and lynched him on the spot. An occupant of the car escaped death by the whippers as he fled the scene.

An eyewitness said: "You

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should have been here to see what happened. There was really no reason for the top speed by the policeman. See how his action led to the death of the three persons on the spot."

The corpses have all been reportedly deposited at various mortuary.
