The university also announced that as result of the intensive search launched by the University Management, the body of Mr. James Oluseun Oyedola, a staff of the English Department, Faculty of Arts, Olabisi Onabanjo University, who had earlier been declared missing since Friday, 23rd June, 2006, was found in the bush behind Popoola
