The killers who also robbed a sister of one of the deceased persons bolted away after the dastard incident but the police in the area were said to be on their trail. The deceased persons were identified as Messrs Orido and Okwagbe.

"Odairo is an electric welder by profession and he, jointly with Walter Tamaratari, constructed a master key, which they had been using to break into people's vehicles", Ek-poudom said.
