••• Three perish in P-Harcourt road crash

THREE persons yesterday lost their lives in an accident involving a tanker with registration number XA 153 DBU and a Mazda saloon car with the number Ekiti AE317 GED, along East-West road.

When Vanguard visited the scene, their corpses were still lying in front of Mobil filling station where the ugly incident occurred. Police men and men of the Federal Road Safety were seen battling to calm angry: youths; who were threatening to set the tanker ablaze. Some people who wolmaterial comments told Vans

collision between the vehicles. They said a Mercedez Benz driver in front of the tanker appeared like one driving and at the same time looking for a filling station to buy fuel."
