

IG mandates policemen to fish out killers of sergeant

ABUJA—FOLLOWING the shooting to death weekend, of a Police Sergeant (Sgt. Sani) attached to the Zone 7 Police Command, Abuja, the Assistant Inspector General in Charge of the zone; Kieran Duderer has given officers and men of the command, one week (7 days) to fish out the killers of the policeman.

According to eye witness report, the policeman in company of three of his colleagues had gone to a popular hotel in Wuse zone 4 to lay ambush for some armed robbery suspects following a tip-off that the robbers who are on police wanted list, had lodged in the hotel.

On getting to the hotel however, the robbers were said to have gone out; prompting the officers to wait for their return. At about 10. 30 pm that Friday (October 13) night, the robbers were said to have returned to their accommodation which is a bungalow."

Just as the Policemen made their move to go arrest the robbers, they (robbers) opened their door and started shooting, killing the leader of the team while two other policemen received gunshot wounds in the ensuing cross fire.

One of the armed robbers, who also got injured in the shootout, was taken away by his colleagues who later scaled the fence to get away. Speaking on the issue yesterday,
