Two feared dead as touts clash in Ajegunle

AGOS—Two persons were yesterday feared dead and several others injured during a bloody clash between factions of motor park touts otherwise known as agbero at Alayabiagba market in Ajegunle, a Lagos surbub.

The clash which paralyzed business activities at the popular market which is also known as boundary market, eye witnesses said, was over ownership of the garage.

Sources said trouble

erupted at about 10am when a faction of the touts stormed the market at about 10am to the incumbent chairman. The touts said to have been armed with dangerous weapons such as cutlasses, broken bottles. charms, amulets and guns; reportedly inflicted injuries on members of the incumbent's faction. The attack, resulted in a free-for all where the supposedly oppressed faction re-enforced and gave their opponents a dose of their own pills.
