Six die in Fulani herdsmen, farmers' clash

GUSAU—SIX persons were killed at the weekend in a bloody clash between herdsmen and farmers in Korenganuwa village, Tsafe Local Government Area of Zamfara.

Eyewitnesses said that the clash left several Fulani cattle rearers and local farmers

seriously injured.

The witnesses said trouble started when migrant herdsmen from the neighbouring Niger Republic invaded some farms in the village with their cattle.

This led to the destruction of produce and animal feeds

valued at millions of naira.

During the clash, the herdsmen were alleged to have shot dead three persons before fleeing the village, while the three others died at the Federal Medical Centre, Gusau.

Four persons were still receiving attention.

Sources said six persons, including the village head, had been arrested in connection with the incident.

Efforts to contact the state Police Public Relations Officer, ASP Lawal Abdullahi, failed as he was said to have travelled out of the state on official assignment.
