Two feared dead in cult clash

PORT HARCOURT—A part three Business Administration/Accounting option students of the Rivers State University of Science and Technology has been reportedly murdered by unknown gunmen at the main campus of the institution yesterday.

When contacted for comments, the state Police PRO,

Mrs. Baresua Ireju confirmed the incident. But sad that she was yet to be thoroughly briefed on it.

He added that policemen had been deplored to the area to maintain peace. However, a source within the university told the *Vanguard* that the student was excused out of a classroom by his assailants. And after a heated argument, which lasted few minutes,

they reportedly pumped volleys of shots into him after which they fled. He was said to have died on the spot.

The source continued that rival cult problems, which have been plaguing the institution for some years might have been the root cause of the callous killing. It would be recalled that in the out gone year the university lost about three students to cult related problems.
