Twenty-two of those that perished in the crash were said to belong to a family whose child was one of those who took part in the maiden convocation ceremony of the Ondo State-owned Adekunle Ajasin University in Akungba-Akoko which was held on Saturday.

Vanguard learnt that the victims of the crash were returning from the ceremony when the unfortunate incident claimed their lives.

The victims, according to sources include one Pa Ogunrinde, his two wives, sons, daughters and relatives who went to felicitate with the son of the late Pa Ogunrinde.

Eye witness account revealed that the crash occurred at a dangerous bend between Iwaro Oka and Oke Maria, some few kilometers from Akungba where the university is situated.

The accident occurred when a truck with registration number, Kano RG 438 NCR had a brake failure and lost control before crushing the commuter bus conveying the 22 passengers including the two six-month old babies.
