

Man beats wife to death

THE Police in Lagos have arrested a man for allegedly beating his wife to death over a yet to be determined circumstance, in Lagos. The suspect identified as Christopher Agbam, is currently being detained at the Homicide section of the State Criminal Investigation Department (SCID) Panti, Yaba.

The arrest was made just as a 42-year-old-man was burnt to death in an inferno that engulfed his building, in Ebute-Metta area of Lagos.

Mr Agbam according to report, had a misunderstanding with his wife last week, which led into a heated argument. A

fight between him and his wife later broke out, in the course of which Mr Agbam two brothers were said to have joined in beating Mrs Agbam, who later slumped. She was said to have been rushed to the hospital where she later gave up the ghost few days later.

Confirming the incident, Police spokesman, Mr Olubode Ojajuni said "Christopher has been arrested while his brothers are on the run. His wife's corpse has been deposited at the mortuary while the case is under investigation"

Meanwhile, tragedy struck Wednesday after a 42 year-old man was burnt to death in an inferno that engulfed a building on number 19 Iya Agan street, off Olokodana, Ebute-Metta.
