

Robbers kill two policemen in Lagos

LAGOS—TWO Police-
men attached to
Mushin division in Lagos
State were weekend shot dead

by armed robbers who were
operating at the Oshodi/Apa-
pa expressway. Three other
members of the force who were
also at the scene narrowly es-
caped with injuries after the
robbers ambushed them at a
spot on the expressway.

Police sources said the
policemen who were on patrol
met the armed robbers at the
expressway where they (rob-
bers) parked the Mitsubishi
commercial bus they were us-
ing around 2:00 a.m. Sunday
and pretended as if they had
a breakdown.

Two members of the force, a

donated to the police by the
Chairman of Mushin local gov-
ernment council for patrol by
the police was also set ablaze
together with the corpse of the
dead policemen by the robbers
who fled the scene later
