Two members of the force, a constable and a sergeant were killed on the spot while the rest escaped with injuries.

The Mitsubishi bus that was donated to the police by the Chairman of Mushin local government council for patrol by the police was also set ablaze together with the corpse of the dead policemen by the robbers who fled the scene later
