Four killed in rival cults clash

In some quarters it is believed that these groups have one link or the other with top politicians scheming for political relevance at one level or the other

On the part of the Police it could be safely concluded that it appears helpless in the ranging cult battles. Nevertheless, the security institution must be commended for being able to occasionally rise up to the challenges.
