

Two feared killed in PDP Lagos Island rally

LAGOS—AT least two persons were feared dead yesterday with another on danger list after a campaign rally of the People's Democratic Party (PDP) on Lagos Island turned violent among the supporters.

Trouble started at about 5 p.m. when the PDP governorship candidate in Lagos State was about to start addressing the party supporters at the venue of the rally at Joseph and Catholic Mission streets.

The party supporter who was injured in the fracas and was on danger list in the hospital was said to have been disarmed of a police rifle and several charms strung across his chest. He was matched at least six times before he was rescued.

As at 9 p.m. last night, fighting continued among the supporters who were using guns and other dangerous weapons with some of the combatants promising to continue until the elections.
