


15 killed in cult clash

ABOUT 15 members of Debam cult group were reportedly killed in Tombia, Rivers state in the early hours of yesterday in a rival cult clash with Outlaws, another cult group. One of those killed, according to sources, is a dreaded cultist, Prince Igodo who was sometime ago declared wanted by the State Security

Service in the state for allegedly sponsoring some of the abductions of expatriate workers in the state.

Sources told *Vanguard* that members of the Outlaws gathered that Prince Igodo was mobilizing to destabilize the swearing in ceremony of the governor-elect in Port Harcourt, and immediately stormed his Tombia hide out, killing him and about fourteen other of his men.
