

One killed in Osogbo car explosion

OSOGBO — ONE person died when a car exploded at Osun State Secretariat in Osogbo yesterday.

The incident which occurred in front of the Ministry of Water Resources located within the premises of the Secretariat was allegedly triggered off by three men who drove into the premises in a Peugeot 505 saloon with registration number AL 850 NND.

Vanguard reliably gathered that the explosion occurred when one of the three occupants of the car attempted to carry out a luggage from the booth of the car.

The incident however, paralysed government activities in the state as civil servants scampered around for safety.

Briefing news men at the scene of the incident, the state police commissioner, Mr. Sulaiman Fakai, explained that bomb experts have been invited to state the nature of the explosive. He also said that preliminary reports on the incident, showed that the substance was an explosive appliances referred to as Improved Explosive Device,
