continued throught the day and fight almost without stopping, before it finally stopped in the afternoon of Friday. Areas like Festac, Satellite Amuwo Odofin, Town, Ajegunle, Orile, Surulere, Ikate,

Idi Araba, Mushin, and Agege were flooded, with many residents scooping water out of their apartments. Low density areas like Ikoyi, Victoria Island and Aja were not spared as traffic was disrupted as roads

were severely flooded. Commuters waited on end in the rain to get to work, with many returning home out of

frustration.
