The state police command, PRO, (DSP) Baba Mohammed, told newsmen that the police were aware of the incident. The case, according to him, was already under investigation, assuring that they would unravel the mystery behind the incident. The mother the girl, Mrs. Chioma Onvenedum, who is nursing a two-month old baby, cried inconsolably when Sunday Vanguard visited the family, muttering words that only she alone could interpret. All she could ask to no one in particular was, "where is my jewel, where is Chidinma; what is happening to us?"

The family lost all they had laboured for in life to the bizarre incident.
