

VP condoles Olajumoke over son's death

VICE President Goodluck Jonathan, weekend, visited the Park View Ikoyi Lagos residence of Senator Bode Olajumoke to condole the family over their son, Oladipo, who died recently in a motor accident in Abuja. The vice president wrote in the condolence register that, "I came with friends to condole you over the death of your beloved son. May God grant you the fortitude to bear the loss". Other notable politicians, friends and associates of Senator Olajumoke

had also visited him and his wife, Remi in Lagos, Abuja and Imeri since Oladipo died on July 30. Politicians across all the political parties paid tribute to the deceased. Earlier callers included Senate President David Mark who led other senators to the Abuja residence of the Olajumokes shortly after the news of the tragic incidence broke. Senators, political office holders from Ondo State and across the country attended Oladipo's burial at Imeri, Olajumoke's country home and

paid tribute to the deceased who studied real estate in England before coming to Nigeria.

Delivering a short sermon during the ceremony, the Bishop of Anglican Communion, Owo Diocese, Rt Rev James Adedayo Oladunjoye, described the deceased as humble and a friend of the masses.

The clergyman pointed out that his close contact with the deceased showed that "the short time he lived he touched the lives of many that came his way."
