

Three chiefs feared dead in Rivers crisis

PORT HARCOURT—
THREE chiefs are feared dead in a crisis that reportedly broke out at Ogogboro in Rivers State yesterday. Details at press time were still very hazy, but community sources told *Vanguard* that there was shooting in the area. The cause of the sad development could not be ascertained.

Meanwhile, the state Commissioner of Police, Mr. Felix Ogbaudu informed *Vanguard* on phone that he also heard of the sad incident but he had

not been able to confirm if any body was killed. According to him, they were in a meeting with service chiefs at the 2 Amphibious Brigade barracks in the state capital when stories filtered in that there was crisis in Ogogboro.

He said they immediately dispatched a team of the Joint Task Force (JTF) to the area but was still waiting for clear information.

Another community source confirmed the arrival of the JTF in the area, saying they were busy ransacking the place for brigands and miscreants.
