One feared dead, 20 houses destroyed in a communal clash

UMUAHIA — ONE person was feared dead and no fewer than 20 houses were destroyed during a communal clash at Ofeme community in Ohuhu, Umuahia North local government area of Abia State over tussle for the traditional ruler of the area.

Several other persons in the community are also reportedly missing, while many others have fled the area and have become refugees in other villages.
