Apparently thinking that he was being attacked by robbers, some of the residents reportedly armed themselves and made for where the

shout was coming from, which turned out to be a shrine, only to behold the headless body of Akin Adisa in the pool of his own

The assailant who was in the company of his mother, was reportedly found with the head splashed with blood. The villagers who were taken aback by the startling discovery, were further shocked when the suspect revealed that the beheaded man was his
