

Three killed, 5 injured in auto crash

LAGOS—THREE persons were killed and five others injured in an accident yesterday on the Lagos-Ibadan Expressway.

Mr Adei Abu, FRSC Zonal Commanding Officer, Lagos,

confirmed the report. He said the accident involved a luxury bus and a truck carrying oranges.

Abu said the bus ran into the truck which had broken down at about 4.30 am on the long bridge, 22 kilometres to Lagos. He said the deceased were the driver, his assistant and conductor of the bus belonging to Chisco Transport Company.

The FRSC official said the bus was travelling to Lagos from the eastern part of the country, while the truck was coming from Ibadan.

The FRSC Unit commander, Mowe, near Lagos, Mr Ojeam-iren, said the injured were receiving treatment at Ikeja General Hospital, where the corpses had also been deposited.
