## Suspected cultists kill student, injure others at UNAD

A DO-EKITI—A PART three student of the University of Ado Ekiti (UNAD) was at the weekend hacked to death by some suspected cultists, while two others were said to have sustained serious injuries during the attack.

The students, whose identities are yet to be ascertained as at the time of going to the press were said to had been "marked down" for elimination by the cultists over some minor scubbles.

The incident was said to

had happened in the wee hours of Firday at Adebayo area in Ado Ekiti where most of the students reside, as the institution operates an offcampus system.

Vanguard gathered that the cultists had vowed to strike and deal with some 'stubborn students', few days before the Friday killing.

The two other students were said to had been matcheted to the extent that they had to be reffered to the Obafemi Awolowo University Teaching Hospital, Ile Ife for medical attention.

Reacting to the incident, the Deputy Vice Chancellor of the University, Prof. Dipo Kolawole who spoke on behalf of the Vice Chancellor, Prof. Isreal Orubuloye, away for a seminar in Tripoli, Libya, denied knowledge of the incident.

The Deputy Vice chancellor who was flanked by the Chief Security Officer (CSO) of the University though admitted that the management of the institution got wind of the plan of some cult members to disrupt the on-going second semester examinations to cover up their act of unseriousness on the campus.
