

Robbers kill one in Osun bank raid

O SOGBO—ARMED robbers yesterday attacked a first generation bank in Iragbiji, Boriye Local Government Area of Osun State, killed one person and carted away an undisclosed amount of money.

The no fewer than 10 robbers were reported to have stormed the premises of the bank about 10.30 a.m. in two separate vehicles and ordered everybody in the banking hall to lie down.

The robbers immediately on arrival started shooting sporadically into the air to scare

people away while the policemen at the bank were overpowered by the hoodlums.

The hoodlums operated for about one hour unhindered as there was no resistance from any quarter. .

The robbers were reported to have escaped with their loots in a 'Ghana Must Go Bag.'

An attempt by the local hunters to resist the robbers failed because of the sophisticated weapons used by the hoodlums, while one of the unidentified young who were mobilising to resist the robbers was shot dead at Ijebu-jesa road.
