

Five persons found dead inside apartment in Badagry community

LAGOS—TRAGEDY struck in Lagos Monday night when five persons were found dead inside an apartment at Okwuakpo, new generation area in Morogbo Community towards Badagry as a result of fumes from a generator set.

One person survived the incident which reportedly took place around midnight last Monday and he is said to be in

critical condition at the Lagos University Teaching Hospital (LUTH), Idi-Araba.

Sources said the incident took place after the man who was identified as Kabiru was visited by his concubine and her three children. It was learnt that both the woman, her children and the commercial motorcyclist that brought them to the area passed the night in Kabiru's house because they arrived late in the night. However, around 12 noon the following day, their neighbours

did not see any sign of life around the apartment and they quickly alerted the nearby police station in the area.

Vanguard learnt that a team of policemen that promptly arrived the scene forcefully broke into the house only to see the dead body of both the man, his concubine and her three children.

Eyewitness account said only the commercial motorcyclist was found unconscious and was rushed to the hospital immediately.
