7 persons feared dead in Isoko South communal clash

OLEH—AT least seven persons were feared dead and property worth several millions of naria razed in an intra communal clash at Ewokpakpa in Isoko South Local Government Area of Delta State, weekend.

Our correspondent reports that trouble started when one indigene of the community allegedly axed one of his kinsmen, one Mr. Benson Ulebe to death. Investigations revealed that the attack was not unconnected with an issue that was settled between the deceased and his assailant sometimes back.

According to a reliable source, the deceased, Mr. Benson Ulebe went to a nearby town to buy bread for his wife who put to birth about two weeks ago, adding that he (Ulebe) was ambushed on his way back.

The source who pleaded anonymous, said the assailant

was caught by youths of the community and handed him over to the police after he was tortured.

Our correspondent further reports that some houses including the community's solar water system, which was provided by government, were set ablaze.
