

Missing Poly lecturer found dead in own farm

MUBI— AFTER missing for one week, a lecturer with the Federal Polytechnic, Mubi, in Adamawa, Mr Faluyi Isaac, was found dead in his farm outside Mubi town.

The News Agency of Nigeria (NAN) reports that the decomposed body of Faluyi was recovered but his motorcycle was missing.

Mr Alfa Jibrin, the Divisional Police Officer (DPO) Mubi South, confirmed the incident.

"When he was traced, it was just bones as most parts of his body were rotten and feasted upon by animals," said the DPO.

Alfa said the remains of Isaac, whose relations could not be traced, was released to the polytechnic for burial while investigation contin-

ued.

Information from the polytechnic indicated that the deceased, a bachelor with no identifiable relations, hailed from Ikare Local Government area of Ondo state.

The 58-year old deceased who was a lecturer in electrical engineering, joined the service of the polytechnic in 1981 and retired in 1993 before he was given a contract appointment.

Commenting on the deceased, the branch chairman of the Academic Staff Union of Polytechnics (ASUP), Mr Maxwell Yakubu, described him as a peaceful, quiet and reserved person who always kept to himself.

Meanwhile, the remains of the deceased was buried at the Mubi cemetery, by staff of the polytechnic.
