Nine die in Plateau auto crash

JOS — A GHASTLY automobile accident weekend, claimed nine lives along the Barakin-Ladi-Jos Road in Plateau State.

The accident occurred at Dorowa village when the vehicles in which they were travelling in opposite direction had a head-on collision at a sharp bend along the highway.

Most of the victims were said to have died instantly and their corpses deposited at the Jos University Teaching Hospital.

The spot is notorious for similar accidents which had claimed

many lives.

Public Relations Officer of JUTH, Mrs. Ngozi Okpara confirmed that the corpses were deposited there, adding that nobody has come forward to identify any of them.

She called on those whose relations travelled along that road on the day of the accident to check at the hospital's mortuary for possible identification of the corpses.
