when dare-devil armed robbers numbering about 20 attacked a bullion van and security men conveying money from Onitsha to Awka at Awkuzu in Oyi local government area of the state and carted away millions of naira in the van. It was the second day-time high profile armed robbery in the state in two months.

NO fewer than five policemen were feared dead yesterday in Anamabra State

The bullet-proof bullion van had left Onitsha at about 10.30 am and was heading to Awka when, unknown to the conveyers, the robbers had waylaid them at a point close to Awkuzu junction.

An eye witness told Vanguard that the robbers fired at the convoy and this forced the two patrol vehicles accompanying the bullion van to run into the headquaters of the State Anti-Robbery Sqaud (SARS) located at Awkuzu, a few meters away, only for the robbers to chase them into the premises where an exchange of fire took place, leaving in its wake, several people dead and many others, mainly police men injured.

While the shooting was going on, the driver of the bullion van tried to speed to Awka through the expressway, but was caught up by the robbers in a four-wheel Toyota landcruiser a few meters to Igbariam junction.

It was not clear what happened to the driver of the bullion van, but the robbers used weilding machines to break into the van and brought out the cash boxes which were also opened with the aid of the weilding machines. For about two hours, the robbers blocked both sides of the Enugu-Onitsha expressway and carefully opened the boxes and removed all the money in them.

Motorists on the ever-busy expressway had to abandon their vehicles and the passengers ran into the bush where stray bullets hit some of them. The numerous check points along the express way were deserted as soon as the robbery began, while policemen at the SARS office ran into the bush.

When Vanguard got to the scene at about 2.30 pm, the bulliion van and the Toyota jeep riddled with bullets were still there. The weilding machines and gas cylinders abandoned by the robbers were also there. There were expended bullets and posters of a political party in the jeep, which was an indication that it might have been snatched from its owner. About 32 empty boxes also littered the scene.

It was gathered that after helping themselves with the money, the robbers turned back towards Awkuzu and shot sporadically when they got to the headquarters of SARS again before heading towards Aguleri in Anambra East local government

It was not possible to confirm the actual number of casualties at press time, although the Deputy Commissioner of Police, Mr. Amusa Bello said in a telephone interview that only one police officer lost his life, while few others



were injured.

According to him, "The true position is that one police man lost his life while some others got injured but I can tell you now that seven of the robbers have died in the police custody. That is the true position right now.

"I can equally tell you that we are not resting on our oars until we track down those criminals and you know we are capable of doing it. Right now, all the police formations in this state have been directed to get to the root of this ugly incident". Two months ago, some armed robbers, ran amorc in Anambra State after robbing a bank in Imo State and engaged policemen in a shoot out at Nimo in Njikoka local government area.

During that incident, three Assistant Superintendents of Police (ASP) including the one in charge of SARS at Awka Central Police Station and four civilians, including a woman, lost their lives.
