Armed robbers yesterday went on the Comment on this article rampage on the Ugbelli/Asaba road in Delta State killing one soldier at a petrol station, at

Ozoro Isoko North Local Government Area of the State.

Vanguard gathered that the armed robbers who struck as early as 6:30 a.m started the robbery operation between Ellu and Emevor robbing traders traveling to Onitsha, Asaba and other parts of their valuables.

According to an eyewitness account, the robbers who stopped over at the AP Petrol station to refill their tank, were engaged in a gun battle by two soldiers attached to an expatriate traveling in a Hilux pickup.

The eyewitness, who pleaded anonymity, said one of the soldiers had to run for his dear life when he saw his colleague in his own pool of blood struggling for breath, leaving behind the expatriate.
