### Gunmen kill corps member in Benin

A 29 year-old National Youth Service Corp (NYSC) member, Miss Osaze Omorodion was murdered weekend in Benin, by unknown gunmen suspected to be hired assasins.

Vanguard gathered that the incident which occurred at the deceased family house, Okungbowa Street, off Siluko Road at about 8:30pm on Saturday, shocked residents of the area because of the fact that the deceased was preparing for her wedding which comes up in a few weeks time.

The mother of the deceased, Madam Racheal fainted after her daughter was shot dead in her present and she is currently receiving treatment at an undisclosed hospital.

The late Miss Omorodion, a graduate of Agric Economics from the University of Benin (UNIBEN) was attached to the Institute of Continuing Education (ICE), off Wire Road in Benin City, for her mandatory one year national service programme.

She was said to have been posted to Kaduna but later sought redeployment to Benin City, where she returned to barely a week before she was murdered. Vanguard learnt that her deployment was to enable her prepare for her marriage which was said to be a few weeks from the Saturday she was killed.

The gunmen who were said to be eight in number, reportedly stormed Miss Omorodion's family home that Saturday and accosted her and her mother, Madam Rachael Omorodion and demanded for jewelries, money and telephone handsets.

According to a nephew of the deceased, Mr. Gideon Eke, "some of the gunmen after sometime shifted attention to her and demanded that she gave them her own jewelries. They later took her to a corner inside the house and they were discussing with her and she was begging them to spare her life but they refused and they shot her several times".

He stated further that after the shooting, the assassins fled the scene with just two of the late Miss Omorodion's mobile phone handsets.

The remains of the deceased had been deposited at an undisclosed hospital by men from the state police command.
