AKURE — TWENTY-FIVE people died in a road accident in Ikare, Akoko North-East Council of Ondo State, yesterday as a trailer loaded with rice ran into a market and crushed the victims, even as dare-devil armed robbers snuffed life out of six people including four policemen when they attacked two commercial banks in the ancient city of Ibadan.

The people who died in Ikare were mostly market women as the trailer was said to have run through the market before it collided with an electricity pole with its front compartment bursting into flames. Many people were also rushed to the hospitals.

An eye-witness said five motorcycles also caught fire as the trailer, a DAF 911, rammed into them by the side of the road, killing two of the riders instantly.

According to the witness, the driver of the truck, marked Ondo: XB 346AKK, with the inscription "Allah Ya Kiyaye" lost control and headed straight into the Oja Oba market.

Vanguard learnt that the driver was descending a hill near the Olukare of Ikare's palace before the mishap. It was gathered that the driver of the trailer fled immediately the accident occurred as sympathisers attempted to set him on fire.

The bags of rice the trailer was transporting were quickly evacuated to the police station in the town. At press time yesterday, the trailer was still at the scene of the crash. Bodies of the deceased have been deposited at the Ikare General Hospital.

Speaking with newsmen, the Federal Roads Safety Commission spokesman, Olugbenga Muhammed, confirmed the crash but was not categorical about the number of the causalities. Speaking with newsmen, the spokesman of the state Police Command, Mr. Aremu Adeniran, however said only nine persons died in the auto crash while four were seriously injured.

Robbers kill six in Ibadan

Meanwhile, six people — four policemen and two students— were killed yesterday in Ibadan in a robbery attack.

Over 20 other people were said to have been wounded when the hoodlums shot indiscriminately while several other passers-by were reportedly shot during a shoot-out between the police and the bandits. The wounded were said to have been rushed to the casualty section of the University College Hospital (UCH), Ibadan.

The robbers who reportedly arrived the bank in buses were said to have successfully robbed a bank where an undisclosed amount of money was carted away. But they could not force their way into the vault of the second bank which is located at Iwo Road.

Confirming the death toll, Mr. Abayomi Adeniji, Deputy Public Relations Officer, told newsmen on phone that "three of the policemen that were killed had mounted a road block at Idi Ape area to prevent the escape of the robbers, while the other one was felled at Bodija Oju Irin. However, one of the robbers was killed while one was arrested. The one killed had an AK47 rifle with him and amulets around his waist."

He said eight of the rampaging robbers entered one of the banks while the others were outside with dangerous weapons. At press time, the police hinted that their men were still on the trail of the armed bandits.

The robbery compelled banks, eateries, shops, supermarkets and other business centres on Secretariat-Bodija-UI road to close shop.

Also confirming the casualty figure, the Public Relations Officer of the UCH, Mr. Kunle Atinwore, said: "Over 20 casualties have been brought to the hospital. Six were dead, while over 20 others were injured. Three of the corpses were policemen."

All outlets to the city were blocked by the policemen while all vehicles were being searched thoroughly.
