FOUR gunmen, Monday night, attacked the Makurdi residence of the Kogi State Commissioner of Police, Mr. Ibezimako Aghanya, killing a mobile police guard and a neighbour.

Another policeman who was shot severally is now in a critical condition at the Federal Medical Centre in Makurdi

Mrs. Eunice Aghanya, wife of the CP, told Vanguard that she was just returning home from an outing at about 7 p.m. when she started hearing sporadic gun shots. It then dawned on her that the house was under attack.

The gunmen shot PC Yinusa Halidu and PC Terhenmen Iornongo attached to 13 PMF Makurdi who were on guard at the residence at the time. A neighbour named Issac Alfa was also hit by the gunmen's bullets.

Mrs Aghanya said she gathered that the gunmen arrived in a Honda car after having patrolled the vicinity earlier in the day.

She added that the two policemen shot by the gunmen were those on the premises. Another policeman who was away on surveillance was attracted to the scene by the gun shots. He returned fire, wounding some of the robbers who later escaped.

Lamenting the demise of PC Yinusa Halidu, she said the wife of the slain Police officer had just put to bed. His body has been taken to his home town for burial according to Islamic rights.

Sources at the State Police Command Headquarters confirmed the incident and said the Police had since commenced investigations into the matter.
