# Police kill two militants in Port Harcourt

TWO militants were gunned down in the early hours of yesterday in Port Harcourt by men of the state Police command.

The Diobu Divisional Police officer, Mr. Emma Asufi told the Vanguard on phone that policemen from his division encountered the hoodlums around the fly-over area of the state capital.

And during the exchange of fire three of the hoodlums fled. He said it was very likely the hoodlums were behind the death of spy police personnel in the area recently.

In a related development, peace has started returning to Obewle community, Emohua Local Government Area following the deployment of men of the Joint Task Force to the area. Spokesman of the security body and the army in the state, Lieutenant Col Sagir Musa said about five persons have so far been arrested in connection with the crisis that engulfed the community between Sunday and Monday night.

He said the JTF razed down a shrine suspected to be serving as hideout for the hoodlums who unleashed mayhem in the town. He could not say if any life was lost during the crisis but he confirmed that the sad development caused residents to desert the town.

"Some cultists unleashed terror in Obewle village. The JTF did what we call appreciation in the area. And finally sector four unit with headquarters in Isiokpo raided the area and destroyed a notorious cult shrine where bandits hang out.

It was burnt. Four suspects arrested there and some charms recovered. No casualty on the part of the civilians and the military during the operation."

Meanwhile, a community source told Vanguard that no fewer than seven persons would have died in the fracas which he said was caused by tussle for a traditional stool.

### ....Kill another two in botched robbery attempt

THE police in Bayelsa State, yesterday, foiled a robbery attempt by a four-man gang operating on a motorcycle and killed two of the suspects.

The incident occurred at about noon in front the Federated Correspondent Chapel secretariat on Tolda Road at the Ekeki suburb of the capital city.

Witnesses told Vanguard that members of the gang numbering about four had trailed their victim who was said to be returning from one of the commercial banks around Ekeki, where he had gone to withdraw a huge sum of money, to Tolda Road when they met their waterloo.

Luck, however, ran out on the four-man gang when some concerned members of the public suspected their movement and alerted the police authorities.

On getting the report of the unusual movement of the robbery suspects, some policemen from the Ekeki Division were hurriedly dispatched to the area on surveillance.

It was gathered that just as one of suspects who was armed with a locally made pistol was about to dispossessed their unsuspecting victim of his money earlier withdrawn from the bank the police team arrived the scene of crime.

Eyewitnesses told Vanguard that the suspects on realizing that they have been cornered by the police opened fire and the security men returned fire killing two of the robbers on the spot while two other members of the gang manage to escape with an Okada.

The remains of the suspects and the locally made pistol and six rounds of live ammunition recovered from them were later taken to the state police command.

The state Assistant Commissioner of Police in charge of operations, Mr. Charles Osegbue who confirmed the incident said the robbery attempt was foiled by his men following a tip-off from members of the public.

Mr. Osegbue used the opportunity to call on members of the public to always avail the command with useful information that would assist the police to rid the state of criminal elements.

He, however, assured that the command has stepped up patrol of all the nooks and crannies of the
