Asaba—A middle-aged man who allegedly killed his own three year old son in a farm recently at Kwale, Delta State has slumped and died.

Vanguard gathered that he slumped in the same farm where he butchered his son with matchet when he led police detectives on investigation to the very spot where the havoc was committed.

Although police detectives, according to eye witness, actually saw blood stain all over the place but could not find the body of the boy. But the suspect shocked the detectives as he suddenly slumped while answering questions.

He was however rushed to Kwale Central hospital where he died later that same day. Meanwhile, the state Police Command's spokesman, Mr. Charles Muka said three persons have been arrested in connection with GSM fraud.
