Man kills mother's friend, dumps her body at GRA

BENIN—PANDEMONIUM broke out yesterday at the Government Reservation Area in Benin City, after a 22 year-old man, Omo Onosose, a native of Etsako local government council of Edo State, murdered one Mrs Helen Airia, who was a friend to the suspect's mother.

The state Police Public Relations Officer, ASP Peter Ogboi, who paraded the suspect to newsmen, said that after committing the act, Omo who just got admission into a university in London, carried the deceased body in the jeep which the deceased drove to the suspect's mother's residence, in collaboration with his girl friend, and dumped the body at Ugbor GRA.

After disposing the body, Omo drove the jeep to his friends' place, where they removed the tyres and sold them for N17,000.

Ogboi who narrated the incident to newsmen, stated that "the deceased visited Omo's house last week to see Omo's mother who is her friend and business partner.

But it happened that she traveled abroad. So Omo (Suspect) tricked her and gave her his number and told the deceased that it was her mother's number that, she should call her mother this week to find out if she is back from abroad.

"So the decease after some day, called the number and Omo picked the phone and told her the mother is back that she should come. The deceased now drove to the house and Omo told her that the she should wait that the mother was around.

While she was waiting in the parlour, Omo locked the door, went inside and brought a pestle and cutlass. He thought the woman came with money, so he used the pestle to hit her head and used the cutlass on her body.

"While this was going on, his girl friend was inside the house and Omo came in and told her to help him dispose the body. Both of them dragged the body to the deceased jeep and dumped her some where at Ugbor.

They took the car to the house of one Osagie, and it was there that they removed the tyres and went to sell them at James Watt. In the course of investigation, we were able to arrest those with the jeep but one Keke is still on the run" he stated.

Speaking to Vanguard, Omo who confessed to be a member of the Eiye confraternity, lamented that " I do not really know what came over me.

I thought she came with big money and that was why when she came, I went and brought the cutlass and pestle to kill her. She pleaded with me but I had to kill her to collect money from her. She said she did not come with any money. And actually after killing her I only found N2,500 with her.

"But I went to sell the tyres at James Watt for N17,000. I do not know what really happened but if I get out of this I will serve God forever" he stated.

The body of the deceased had been deposited at the mortuary, while the police said investigations are still going on.
